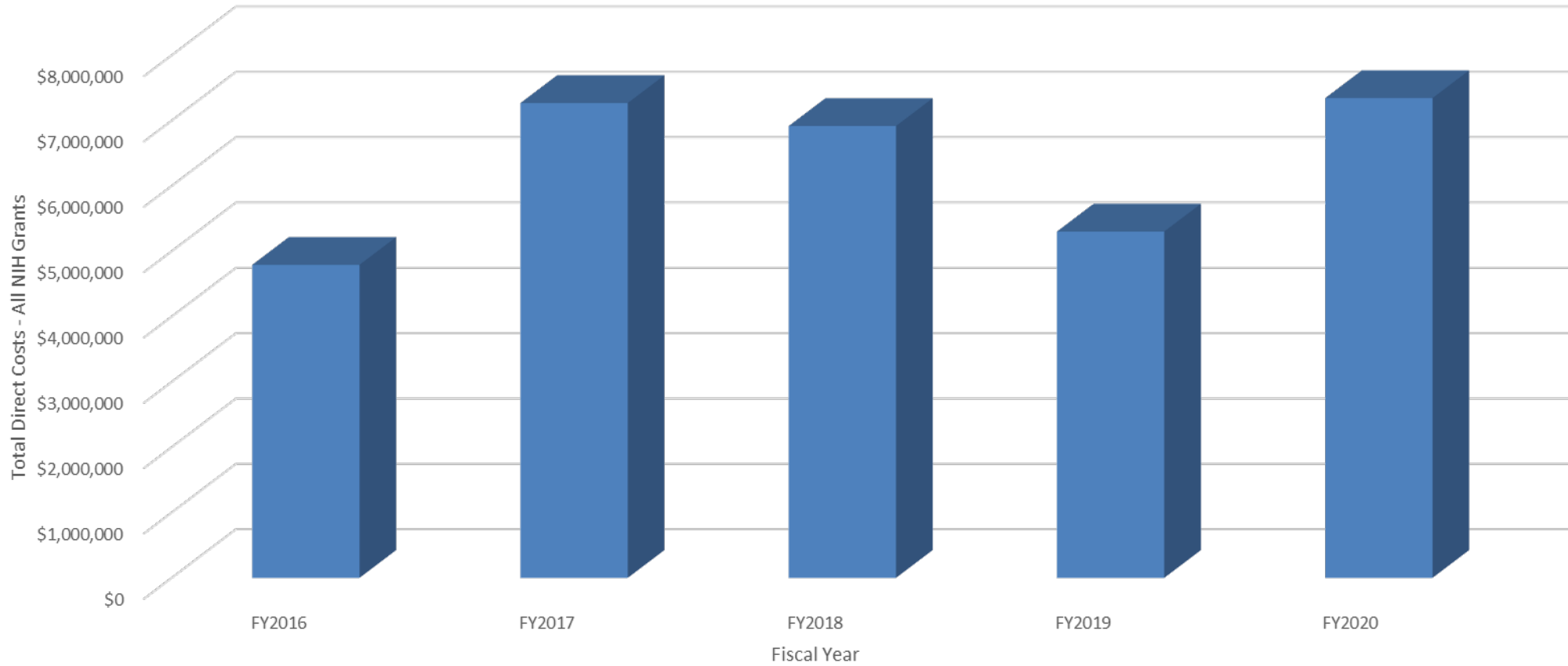




Timeline: Research on SUDEP

- 2002: Jeanne Donalty teamed up with CURE to raise funds for SUDEP research in memory of her son, Christopher
- 2004: CURE launches SUDEP Research Grants program and funds first grant
- 2005: CURE and AES partner to hold workshop on SUDEP at annual AES meeting
- 2008: First scientific workshop on SUDEP
- 2012: Partners Against Mortality in Epilepsy (PAME) Conference
- 2014: Center for SUDEP Research, an Epilepsy Center Without Walls, funded by NINDS

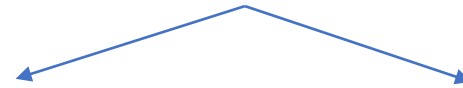
